## Parent Education Programs

### **Hanen Parent Programs: More Than Words & It Takes Two To Talk**

Specialized therapeutic programs for parents, guardians and caregivers of young children. Classes are appropriate for families of children ages 1½-6. These programs include group sessions as well as personal videotaping/feedback sessions and are facilitated by Speech-Language Pathologists.

It Takes Two To Talk - Children with expressive language delays.  
More Than Words - Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder or suspected ASD

### **Talking And Learning About Kids (TALK)**

FREE parent education series offers information on developmental milestones for speech/language, oral/fine motor, sensory integration and play. Provides information about community resources and support groups to help parents, families and caregivers find needed resources in central Ohio. TALK is funded by Ohio Children's Trust Fund.

TALK is appropriate for:

- Parents, families and caregivers of children ages 1½-6.
- Parents that are interested in learning about child development
- Parents of children with a speech/language and/or social interaction delay.
- Parents of a child who has recently failed a speech screening.

TALK is held 4 times per year. Call for session dates.

## Group Speech Therapy Programs: Summer ONLY

### **“R” Made Easy (R-Me)**

Weekly group therapy program for children, ages 7-12, who are able to produce the “R” sound in words but have difficulty in conversations.

### **Secret Service**

Weekly group therapy for children, ages 5½-8, who are able to produce “S” “Z” “SH” “CH” & “J” sounds in words but have difficulty in conversations.

### **Motor Mouth**

Weekly group therapy for children, ages 3-5, who have a severe articulation disorder. This group will focus on improving intelligibility of speech.



## Year-Round Programs

### **Language & Early Learning Program (LELP)**

Group therapy program for children, ages 2½-6, with delays in language development. LELP uses a classroom setting to provide speech and occupational therapy and is accredited by The National Association for the Education of Young Children.

### **JAM**

Program provides individual and group therapy for children, ages 2-6, who have language, peer interaction and/or communication deficits. Children may be diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

### **Tiny Talkers**

Weekly group therapy for children, ages 18-36 months, with expressive language delays. A preschool model is used to target early language goals.

### **Fun With Friends**

Weekly group therapy for children, ages 4-7, who experience challenges interacting with friends. This group focuses on improving interaction skills with peers.

### **Social “Eyes”**

Weekly group therapy for children, ages 8-13, who have difficulty with social interactions. This group focuses on improving the skills needed to succeed in everyday interactions with others.

## Group Occupational Therapy Programs: Summer ONLY

### **Yoga for Children**

Weekly group therapy program for children, ages 5-8, with gross motor difficulties, body awareness or strength issues. Children should be able to follow simple directions and stay in a group given minimal redirection.

### **Writing**

Weekly group therapy for children having difficulty with handwriting. Focuses on postural control, visual motor and letter formation using Handwriting With Tears.

### **Picky Eaters**

Bi-weekly occupational therapy program for children, ages 4-6, who tolerate a limited variety of foods. This group will focus on decreasing food sensitivities and increasing diet variety.



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
