



JAM

JAM is an opportunity for young children with language, peer interaction and/or communication deficits to interact in a group setting and to receive individual intervention to support their success. JAM includes three sessions per week - two one-hour group meetings and one ½-hour individual session.

Activities in the group setting target social, communication, cognitive and motor skills as well as receptive and expressive language, and are staffed by at least two speech-language pathologists with additional help from volunteers or students as available.

Individual sessions target skills needed to support a child's participation in the group setting and are staffed by one of the two therapists.

The maximum number of students in each class is five. The children are grouped with others who display similar language, communication and interaction needs. Children may have diagnoses outside of speech and language.

**JAM group sessions are currently offered on Monday and Wednesday
in the morning or afternoon.**

Individual sessions are arranged with family & therapist.

Cost of JAM is \$300.00 per month.
